Data Grade and Quality Assurance Guide

1. General Information

The data provided within the Environmental Data WebPortal is intended to provide general information to the public and AWL Stakeholders. It is essential for the end user to recognize the limitations and inherent variability of water quality data, as it is easily affected by sample collection and analysis methods, accuracy of sensors, and QA/QC processes. Although efforts are made to ensure the accuracy of the information contained, users should use caution when making decisions based on the data.

It is essential that an understanding of the data collection methodologies used, data limitations and intended purpose of the original data sets are known by the end user. Affinity Water Limited (AWL) implements a grade (quality code) and approval level (quality assurance) schema that provides insight and detail for the end user, as well as highlighting any need to review supplementary data, comments or other associated metadata.

Time series data sourced from AWL should only be used once its fitness for purpose is understood. It is the user's responsibility to determine if the data is appropriate for its intended use and communicate any assumptions in its use.

It should be noted that grades and approval levels can potentially change over time as a result of the data audit process and/or improved knowledge regarding the data and its interpretation.

2. Grade

Grades are used to record the subjective quality of the data. The table below summarizes the quality codes used for grading by AW:

Grade	Description
-4 – GAP	Typical data gaps during field visits (e.g. logger stopped to download data) or missing data (e.g. due to logger failure)
0 – UNDEFINED	Data has yet to undergo quality check and is subject to change
2 – DRY	Dry conditions (e.g. no flow)
3 – NMF	Non measurable flow
4 – ESTIMATED	The value is estimated
11 – SUSPECT	Data is compromised in its ability to represent the monitored parameter
21 – MISSING	Data is missing from the record (e.g. unable to spot gauge due to unsafe conditions or unable to access the location)

31 – GOOD	Data is considered a good representation of the monitored
	parameter

3. Approval Level

The Approval Levels describe the progression of the data through the quality assurance processes and it should be referred to in association with the Grades. Below are the Approval Levels used by AW:

Approval Level	Description
900 – Working	Data has yet to undergo quality check and is subject to change
1100 – In Review	Data is in the process of being quality assured and is, therefore, subject to change
1200 - Approved	Data has been quality assured and is approved for use
